






Community midwifery education program

The CMW education program is an eighteen months midwifery course that has been designed for training rural females as midwives who can provide maternal and newborn care to women and children of their communities. Rural females meetings the CMW eligibility criteria to this program will be through formal selection process.

Community Midwifery Examination Rules and Policies

The midwifery examination system has to follow the rules of the provincial Nursing Examination Board (NEB). In order to be eligible to sit in the exam each student must have attended a minimum of 85 % of Interactive discussions and practical on job training respectively. This should be supported by a certificate by the head of the institution, prior to the examination. The fee for examination will be as per NEB policy.

Theory and skills must be cleared separately, the minimum passing marks required to be obtained in all subjects will be as follow:

- Written 50%
- OSCE 75%

However, passing marks for skill assessment will be increased to 75% in phased manner, over a period of five years. PNC will announce minimum passing score for skills, on yearly basis.

Community Midwifery Examination System:

The examination system is comprised of:

Internal Examination:

At the end of 10 weeks, there will be an internal examination to be arranged by the midwifery school. Students unsuccessful will be reexamined after 4 weeks. If unable to clear the second attempt the student will be excluded from the course.

Nursing Examination Board (NEB):

After completion of the course, the students will appear in the NEB examination.

Community Midwife (CMW) (18 months Diploma Program)

- a. **Qualification:** Matric (either Art or Science) with 40% marks ·
- b. Age Limit: 14-40 years

Lady Health Visitor

Lady health visitor (LHV) is a main community Health worker so her purposes are based on community health requirements and associated health problems and not only rural community health services. The LHV effectively completed the approved course of the subject and acquires diploma which is recognized by Pakistan nursing council. And the health worker to use her knowledge in providing nursing care to well and sick individuals and finalize in MCH centers and communities she will be responsible for prevention of disease promoting and maintaining health theory. The Pakistan nursing council keeping all the above in view and the requirements of both urban and rural areas of the country appointed a sub-committee for the revision of existing curriculum of LHV. This syllabus covers the entire requirement in the enhancement of knowledge of the students.

Course explanation:

One week will be dutiful towards orientation during which the students get recognizable to the new environment recognize the course of training and also accomplish the constraint desire for their admission in the institution. The rest of the period is given to concise the students with the knowledge of the basic science in the field of Microbiology, physiology, pharmacology first Aid and nursing dealings.

DECORUM LETTER

It has been observed that there are certain points regarding decorum, etiquette and discipline of the institute which need extra attention. Violation of any rule and regulation and decorum of the institute is very harmful tendency and smites that very of discipline Without discipline a student cannot make any satisfactory head way in studies nor in later life. Regularity, punctuality and observation of uniform and code etc are the base for any personality development to be constructed on. So into the complete fulfillment of the desired concern of the Institute and regular presence of your son / daughter we would need your whole hearted corporation. Our joint effort can certainly help to overcome these tendencies. The points to be stressed upon are:

LATE ARRIVAL

It has been observed that even having very reasonable college timings in the area students usually come late. So to overcome the tendency decision have been made

by the College administration. The students are bound to abide by these rules and directive issues time to time in this regard, as well.

1.Students coming late up to five minutes will be fined. For habitual late comers, parents will be called to give and undertaking about timely arrival of their son/ daughter. If that even does not work the students name will be struck off.

LEAVE PROCEDURE

In case of genuine and necessary reason and

students/ guardian should send leave application along with a photocopy of the Guardians ID card same as mentioned in the admission form with the signature of the same Guardian. Leave application should only be submitted in the reception where it will be verified and then we'll be sent to the respective classes if verification thrives.

PROCEDURE OF VERIFICATION

Verification means to see and check the history of the student concerned whether he is habitual absentee or have a good attendance record. Only applications of students having good attendance record are accepted and is on the discretion of the class teacher. Student absent for 2 to 4 days in a month without any written application will be fined Student absenting themselves from the class for five or more days in a month consecutive or interval will be expelled from the institute and explanation letter will be issued. Students absenting themselves on days immediately after or before holidays will be fined which may be rupees 100 or 200 per day or more. Other important days like class test, functions, sports days and parent teacher meeting days may also be included in this category.

PROPER UNIFORM

Make sure that uniform should be accordance with the details given in this prospectus. Hair cut it is the most problematic issue: make sure that the hair of your son should be as short as that they might not need to comb to settle. No gel or wet effect cosmetics should be used. If their hair cut found not proper at the checking then they will be enforced to make their haircut in nearby barber shop on payment. We hope that you will understand the need of the application of these rules and stand with us for their fulfillment however we anticipate that you will send your word to the college regularly and according to the decorum in the above-mentioned measures will not be required to be taken.

COLLEGE RULES AND REGULATION

- 1.Roll call is maintained in every class
- 2. For sitting in the annual or semester exam it is obligatory for a students to have 85% attendance during the session or semester.
- 3. For leave the father/ Guardian of the student mentioned in admission form will have to come personally and tell reason or any application maybe send which is signed and supported by the copy of Guardians NIC. Call or telephonic messages are not entertained in this regard and student is marked absent.
- 4. For sick leave the application must be supported by the doctor's certificate.
- 5.In case of absence at least RS 100 per day is charged as fine.
- 6. To maintain maximum attendance various steps are taken.
- 7. Every day this is must for each student to be in the college premises at least 15 minutes before the start of the first lecture and no excuse will be entertained in this regard.
- 8.Late Comers are charged with heavy fine.
- 9.Before the classes are off no student is allowed to leave the college building otherwise strict action is taken.
- 10. No student is allowed to leave the college during working hours, so parents/ Guardians are expected to co-operate with the college and Administration in this regard. Short leave is strictly prohibited,
- 11. Telephonic conversation and messages are strictly prohibited, therefor parents and well-wishers are advised not to make contact on phone.

DRESS INSPECTION

- 1.Student uniform will be inspected everyday
- 2. Heavy fine and Temporary expulsion from classes are levied to the students not wearing neat and clean dress daily.
- 3. Prescribed uniform, hair accessories in case of girls and prescribed hair cut (officers cut) properly polish shoes, properly trim nails and clean teeth are checked on daily basis.
- 4.Only officer cut is allowed. Hair growth over and beyond the ears or touching shirt collar on the back is accounted as violation and taken seriously.
- 5. Parents may, therefore please ensure compliance of the same.
- 6. Jackets and joggers are not allowed.
- 7. Use of wrist chains or around the neck or any other similar practice is forbidden.
- 8. Pressed uniformed and polished shoes are the pre requisites of a smart turnout.

Expulsion Regulations

Expulsion of any harmful student is the primary right of the principal. Any action of the Principal or Board of Management cannot be challenged in any Court of law. Principal is authorized to struck off any student in the best interest of the college without any prior written notice and without assigning any reason, as an administrative matter. It is not necessary to justify. A student declared fail in college internal examination and expelled from the college will not be readmitted in any case, however he/ she have to pay all the dues of the college for the full session.

Permanent Expulsion In case of Expulsion a written notice of Expulsion is issued to the student concerned or maybe posted to registered post. - 13. Interference in college education process like strike and grouping for suspension of classes etc.
- 14. A student involved in any such activities will be warned once before expulsion.
- 15. Flagrant defiance of rules in the classes or elsewhere may lead to immediate expulsion from the college
- 16. Students are not allowed to borrow anything from/to one another.



RULES AND REGULATIONS

Definition

In these regulations unless there is any thing repugnant to context otherwise the following expression shall have the meaning as assigned to them herein.

- a) Student means a student on the roll of the pharmacy institute.
- b) Indiscipline means any act, which disturb the smooth running and good. order of the institute.
- c) Expulsion' means cancellation of admission of the student debarring him/her from the admission at least for one calendar year.
- d) Rustication' means removal of student from the roll of the institute for one or more calendar years or the remainder of the current year in which the order is passed and barring the student to appear in final examination.

ATTENDANCE / LEAVE

- 1. Full day attendance in the theory, practical and on the job training is essential to be counted as presence for the whole day. A fine of Rs. 100/- be charged for each absentee.
 - 2. 80% attendance is mandatory to become eligible for appearing in each semester examination.
- 3. Leave applications are not accounted for the purpose of attendance but are necessary for information about health / where abouts of the students. A student will not be granted more then 6-days continous leave at a time. However, in exceptional cases, the competent authority can grant leave but on the risk of the student of dropping out the course. Application should be submitted prior to (at least one day)/avaiing the leave with student's section of the office.
- 4. A student whose record shows contious absence for two weeks from the course is liable to have his/her name struck off the roll with out any notice.
- 5. For medical leave and medical cover administrators/ MS of the respective hospitals will countersign the medical certificates etc.

PROGRESS REPORT/ELIGIBILITY FOR APPEARING IN THE EXAMINATION

A candidate must fulfill the following criteria to make himself/herself eligible for the examination.

- 1. He/she must complete the prescribed course of the institute in the discipline in which he/she desires to appear in the examination.
- 2. He/she must acquire 80% attendance in all subjects including demonstration, practical and on the job Training classes.
- 3. He /She must show satisfactory academic progress i.e 33% score in the internal assessment.
 - 4. He/she must bear a good character/conduct and abide by the rules of the institute.

COORDINATION WITH PHARMACY

- 5. For this purpose
- a. The institute shall maintain a thorough and up to date record of the academic progress of the of the students through internal assessment in the form of monthly test, attendance, general attitude and behavior towards discipline / rules and regulation of the institute.
- b. The results of the internal assessment shall be recorded and conveyed to
 KP Pharmacy Council for incorporation in the results of comprehensive examination.
- c. Any student who fails to score 40% marks in the internal Assessment or whose progress in not satisfactory, shall not be recommended/ Forwarded to Pharmacy Council for examination.
- 6. Student who fails in two consecutive comprehensive examinations in all subjects shall be struck off from the College.
